### Financial Aid

If you need to apply or re-apply for financial aid, please bring your 2015 tax return and any other statements of income and benefits information.

All students are welcome to apply for financial aid ([www.fafsa.edu.gov](http://www.fafsa.edu.gov)) before coming in to register. UCB's institution code is 031305.

Students who meet income guidelines, but are otherwise ineligible for financial aid, may be eligible for \$300 of institutional aid per course tuition. Final approval for institutional aid requests is made by the Dean of Administration & Finance.

If you are planning to register for three classes, bring a copy of your health insurance card.

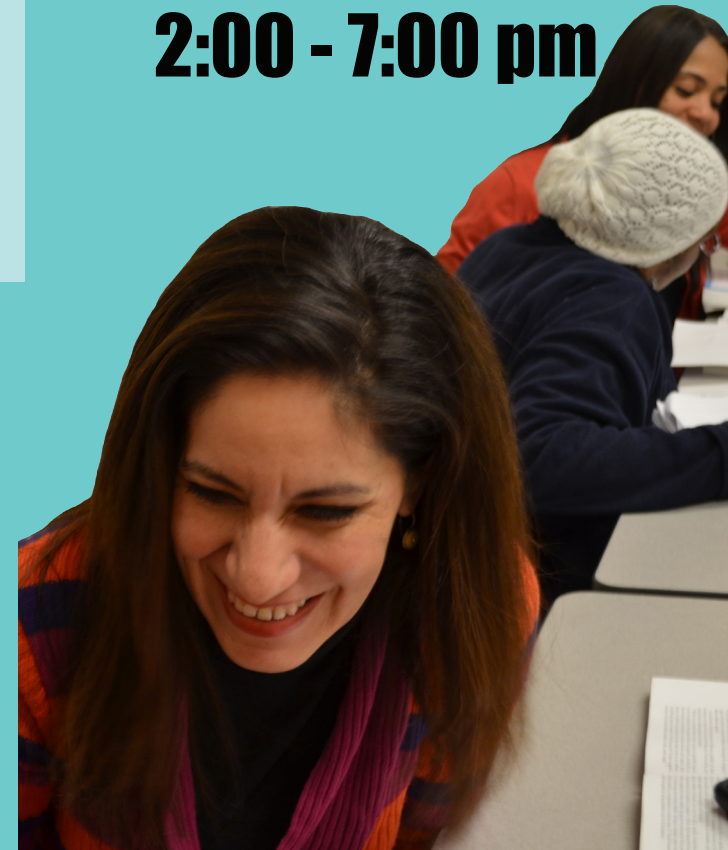
