Urban College of Boston (UCB) has launched **Foundation for Success**, a full-time Associate Degree program for recent Boston Public School (BPS) graduates.

Is this program for me?

This program is for you if you:

- Are motivated, want to attend college, and are willing to commit to a full-time, daytime program.
- Are a recent BPS graduate under age 24.

What will it cost me?

If you qualify for a Pell Grant, your costs will be fully covered by the program, including:

- Tuition (beyond your Pell Grant)
- Books
- Fees

If you are ineligible for a Pell Grant, there are limited scholarship funds available that may help cover the cost of your enrollment. Please contact Rebecca Aponte (617-449-7042) to learn more.

What does the program include?

- No out-of-pocket costs for up to two years of full-time enrollment for those who qualify for Pell Grants.
- 8 core classes during the 1st year to lay the foundation for future success in college.
- Various options for associate degrees and certificates, including Early Childhood Education, Human Services Administration, General Studies, Criminal Justice, Business, and Management.
- Intensive, individualized coaching and advising.

What can I do with my associate degree?

- Continue your education - credits transfer seamlessly to other colleges and universities.
- Join the workforce - our program includes career exploration through job shadowing, internships, and/or part-time employment.

Why “Foundation for Success”?

The first few years of college are key for your future educational and career success. As you strive toward your educational goals, we will provide the academic, career, and other supports needed to help you achieve your dreams. The program is:

- Designed for you, with small classes, a tight-knit college community, and individualized support.
- Located at UCB’s new campus in the heart of downtown Boston, in the midst of numerous colleges and universities.
- Easily accessible via the MBTA.
